drivers permission to transport other students to or from school without the written consent of parents of	
students requesting such rides. Transporting other students without parental consent to school may result in	
revocation of driving privileges and/or disciplinary measures. Student drivers are required to leave the parking l	lot ir
an orderly manner while maintaining a fifteen foot distance between vehicles. I understand that under no	
circumstances will the student leave the school grounds during the school day without first getting permission from	om
the school office to do so. Students must use the student parking lot. After parking and locking their vehicles,	
students must leave the area immediately. Students are not permitted to sit on or in vehicles before school, after	
lunch or during school hours. Vehicles are to be operated in a safe manner at all times. Students may not joy-ride	e on
school property or adjoining streets before or after school, thus eliminating the possibility of accidents during the	e
hours when highways adjacent to the school property are heavily congested. Student drivers are required to ident	tify
the vehicles they drive via the purchase of student vehicle identification tags. This tag is to be affixed to the mirr	or o
the vehicle. Only one tag will be issued per vehicle. The cost of the tag is \$15.00 for each student. Tag fee mone	еy
will not be refunded if student driving privileges are suspended or terminated due to driving regulation infraction	ns.

	19. M.A.S.D. has partnered with the Meyersdale Borough Police to patrol school grounds. Any vehicle on school grounds will be checked for parking permits and will be visually checked for items of concern. The school district has the right to search all vehicles on school grounds with reasonable suspicion (based on Policy 226.)
	18. Violation of any of the above rules may result in suspension or loss of the driver's privileges.
	17. Students are not permitted to sit on or in vehicles before school, at lunch or after school hours.
	16. All vehicles must be locked during the school day.
	15. Students must exit their vehicles immediately upon parking on the lot.
	14. Students are not to drive or park at the elementary school.
	13. Students may not drive in the service area of the high school or elementary school.
	12. Students are not permitted to drive to the Vo-Tech School unless permission is granted from Vo-Tech and home school.
	11. Students riding to school with a student driver must have parental and school permission forms filed in the office prior to riding with that student.
	10. Motorcyclists leave the parking lot first followed by seniors, juniors and sophomores. Drivers are dismissed by rows. Do not move your vehicle without permission.
	9. Student drivers must maintain a 15-foot distance between vehicles when exiting the parking lot.
	8. Student drivers leaving the parking lot are to do so in an orderly and safe manner.
	7. All buses leave the parking lot before student drivers leave the lot. Violations will result in automatic suspension of driving privileges.
	6. Students are not permitted to leave the school grounds during the day without written permission from the high school office.
